President Costa called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

I. ROLL CALL

The Board Secretary took a roll call of the Board. The following directors were present: Ted Costa, Marty Hanneman, Ken Miller, Dan Rich and Pam Tobin.

II. PUBLIC FORUM

President Costa introduced and announced that SSWD's newly-elected President Kevin Thomas would like to continue with the 2x2 study on collaboration/integration and President Costa would like this to be put on an agenda. Mr. Thomas addressed the Board and agreed with President Costa's comments.

III. 2020 COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS

President Costa reviewed the 2019 committee list and charters. After Board discussion, he removed the Legal Affairs Committee from the standing committee list, with the understanding that the committee could be brought back if needed. In addition, any legal matters will be brought to the full Board for review under Regular or Closed Session as needed via the General Manager or directly to the Board. President Costa requested

that evaluation of Legal Counsel services be placed on the next meeting agenda under Closed Session.

After Board discussion, President Costa appointed the internal committee assignments listed below, and requested that each committee review their charter at their first meeting. In addition, he changed the name of the Water Supply & Reliability Committee to the Urban Water Management/Water Supply Committee. President Costa created the Collaboration/Integration Ad Hoc Committee that is related to the collaboration study with other water agencies while the 2x2 SSWD/SJWD Ad Hoc Committee is dormant.

President Costa moved to appoint Marty Hanneman as the Regional Water Authority (RWA) Representative, with Ted Costa as the Alternate Representative and Pam Tobin as the Second Alternate Representative. Director Hanneman seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Director Rich confirmed that no action was being taken on GM Helliker's position with RWA.

President Costa moved to recommend Ted Costa as Representative, Marty Hanneman as Alternate Representative, and Pam Tobin as Second Alternate Representative to the Sacramento Groundwater Authority (SGA) Board of Directors, for submittal to Sacramento County Board of Supervisors for ratification. Director Hanneman seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

IV. RECOGNITION OF STEVE NUGENT, CARMICHAEL WATER DISTRICT

President Costa announced that Steve Nugent retired from Carmichael Water District and there is a resolution in recognition of his service.

Vice President Tobin moved to adopt Resolution 20-01 in Recognition of 37 years of Service to the Water Community by Carmichael Water District General Manager, Steve Nugent. Director Hanneman seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

V. ADJOURN

The meeting was adjourned 6:52 p.m.

GM Helliker reported that he will be attending the Mid-Pacific Water Users' Conference which conflicts with the January 22nd Board meeting and requested that the meeting be moved to January 23rd. President Costa inquired what agenda items were on the agenda for the next meeting – GM Helliker stated that the items include the Legal Counsel Evaluation, the GM Evaluation and Engineering Committee items from next week's meeting, and Ms. Silva commented that there will be an introduction for an Ordinance amendment. Mr. Horowitz informed the Board that the introduction of an Ordinance cannot occur at a Special Meeting and he will not be available on January 23rd. In addition, Director Tobin is not available on that date. The meeting date was not changed.

President Costa requested that Ideas & Suggestions from Board members be added to regular Board meeting agendas. The Board Secretary will update the next agenda.
