### **Be Efficient**

2021 is one of the driest years on record and storage levels in Folsom Reservoir are low. We all need to do our part to make sure we use water as efficiently as possible as we head into the hotter months of the summer.


Because outdoor irrigation is the biggest water user around our homes, we ask that you water no more than three days per week. We will also be notifying customers if they have excessive irrigation runoff and providing information on how to reduce or prevent the runoff. We have increased funding for the smart irrigation control rebate program. If you haven't already purchased a weather based timer, it is a good time to do so.
