

# DONE & DONE! Oak and Main Avenue Pipeline Projects Complete

This fall, San Juan Water completed two important pipeline upgrade projects. These projects were unique compared to other pipeline replacements because they involved sliplining. Sliplining is a trenchless rehabilitation process for existing pipelines whereby a smaller pipe is installed into the existing pipe, grouting the space between and sealing the ends.

For those of you impacted by construction, thank you for your patience while you received your water supply through temporary service piping and experienced other inconveniences. The upgraded pipelines will provide you with continued, high-quality water supply for many years to come.

## BY THE NUMBERS

**Oak Avenue:** Filbert Avenue to 9219 Oak Avenue, including Casa Roble High School. Upgraded **1,465 lineal feet** of aging steel pipeline.

**Main Avenue:** Main Avenue between Lake Natoma Drive and Twin Lakes Avenue. Upgraded **900 lineal feet** of aging steel pipeline.
