Steps to receive a rebate:

1. Call San Juan Water District to schedule an inspection of current irrigation system.
2. Staff will make recommendations to improve the efficiency of customer's irrigation system.
3. Customer shall prepare a landscape design plan to improve irrigation efficiency and submit to San Juan.
4. After approval, customer may purchase and install equipment.
5. Customer to call San Juan at 791-2663 to schedule a follow up Landscape Irrigation Review.
6. If the improvements meet San Juan's approval, customer shall complete, the rebate application, attach the original receipts, and submit the application to San Juan for processing. Rebates will be issued in the form of a bill credit.

Terms and Conditions

1. The Irrigation Improvement Rebate Program will be administered by the San Juan Water District.
2. Any eligible irrigation equipment must be purchased and installed between July 1, 2008 and June 30, 2009.
3. Eligible irrigation equipment includes equipment that improves irrigation efficiencies as determined by San Juan Water District conservation staff. Efficiencies may include:
 - a. The removal of an old irrigation timer and replacement with an ET controller or one that has a rain sensor, multiple program start times, and/or soil moisture sensor.
 - b. Conversion of spray systems to drip irrigation.
 - c. Retrofit existing non-efficient spray heads with matching precipitation heads.
 - d. Removal of leaking or broken equipment and replace with new equipment.
 - e. Materials associated with system design improvements that will increase watering efficiencies.
4. To be eligible for consideration for participation in the program:
 - a. Property address where equipment is installed must be located in the San Juan Water District retail service area.
 - b. Applicant must have a water account with the San Juan Water District.
5. Eligibility
 - a. Customer must have an existing underground irrigation system with an operable automatic controller.
 - b. Current controller must meet at least two of the following conditions to be eligible for replacement:
 - i. Has only one watering program
 - ii. Cannot water in one minute increments
 - iii. Does not allow for multiple program start times
 - iv. Does not allow for a rain sensor
 - v. Does not allow you to set clock for interval watering days and individual watering days
 - c. Customer must agree to a Landscape Irrigation Review (LIR) prior to rebate distribution. Verification of installation will be conducted at time of LIR.
 - d. Customer must allow San Juan Water District staff to establish the initial programming of the irrigation controller. San Juan Water District or its staff shall not be held responsible for any controller or irrigation system malfunctions, changes in Applicant's water use, or any damage to landscape as a result of landscapes adjusting to changes in watering schedules, if any.
6. San Juan Water District reserves the right to verify the purchase and installation location of any system for which a rebate is requested.
7. Rebate program is subject to available funding. Rebates will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until funding is depleted. Submission of an application does not guarantee a rebate.
8. San Juan Water District will provide reimbursement of 50% of total material cost (labor not included) up to a maximum of \$500 per residential site and \$1,500 per commercial site.
9. Rebate will be issued in the form of a bill credit.
