Steps to receive a rebate:

1. Call San Juan Water District (SJWD) to schedule an inspection of current irrigation system.
2. Staff will make recommendations to improve the efficiency of customer's irrigation system.
3. After initial appointment, customer may purchase and install irrigation materials to upgrade their system.
4. After parts have been installed, Customer shall complete rebate application and attach copies of all itemized receipts and/or contractor's itemized invoices.
5. Customer shall call SJWD at 791-2663 to schedule a walk-thru appointment so that staff can verify installation of irrigation materials. Staff will pick up your application and itemized receipts and/or contractor's itemized invoices during this visit.
6. Staff will review your application and receipts to determine rebate eligibility. 50% of the cost of eligible irrigation materials will be considered for rebate up to the maximum allowed and will be issued in the form of an account credit.

Terms and Conditions

1. The Irrigation Improvement Rebate Program will be administered by the San Juan Water District.
2. All eligible irrigation parts must be purchased and installed between July 1, 2011 and June 30, 2012.
3. Eligible irrigation materials include parts that improve irrigation efficiencies as determined by San Juan Water District conservation staff. Eligible materials may include:
 - a. The removal of an old irrigation timer and replacement with an ET controller or one that has a rain sensor, multiple program start times, and/or soil moisture sensor.
 - b. Conversion of spray systems to drip irrigation.
 - c. Retrofit existing non-efficient spray heads with matching precipitation heads.
 - d. Removal of leaking or broken irrigation materials and replace with new parts.
 - e. Materials associated with system design improvements that will increase watering efficiencies.
4. Eligibility
 - a. Property address where irrigation materials are installed must be located in the San Juan Water District retail service area.
 - b. Applicant must have a water account with the San Juan Water District.
 - c. Customer must have an existing underground irrigation system with an operable automatic controller.
 - d. Current controller must meet at least two of the following conditions to be eligible for replacement:
 - i. Has only one watering program
 - ii. Cannot water in one minute increments
 - iii. Does not allow for multiple program start times
 - iv. Does not allow for a rain sensor
 - v. Does not allow you to set clock for interval watering days and individual watering days
 - e. Customer must agree to a Landscape Irrigation Review (LIR) prior to upgrading irrigation system.
 - f. Customer must make a follow-up appointment for San Juan Water District staff to verify installation of irrigation materials to be eligible for a rebate.
6. SJWD and/or its staff shall not be held responsible for any controller or irrigation system malfunctions, changes in Applicant's water use, or any damage to landscape as a result of landscapes adjusting to changes in watering schedules.
7. SJWD reserves the right to verify the purchase and installation location of any system for which a rebate is requested.
8. Rebate program is subject to available funding. Rebates will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until funding is depleted. Submission of an application does not guarantee a rebate.
9. SJWD will provide reimbursement of 50% of total material cost (labor to install irrigation equipment not included), up to a maximum of \$500 per residential site and \$1,500 per commercial site.
10. Rebate will be issued in the form of an account credit.
11. Retain your completed application form and your original sales receipt(s) until all planned improvements have been completed and installation of all irrigation materials has been verified by SJWD staff.
