UPDATED TOILET REBATES

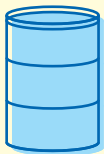

WINTER WATER SAVING TIPS

There are lots of ways to be water efficient in the wintertime.



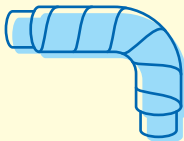
Install a rain barrel to collect any rainwater from your gutters. It's an affordable and easy way to collect natural water.



Instead of pouring everyone a glass of water, **put a pitcher of water** on the table and let your guests serve themselves. Use any leftover water on your houseplants.



Serving up a big holiday meal? **Clean off dirty plates** by scraping food into the compost bin or trash instead of using the garbage disposal.



Insulate any exposed pipes to prevent heat loss and reduce chances of freezing and/or bursting.

Water efficiency doesn't stop outdoors. Keep an eye around your home for ways to be efficient this winter.

- **Replace any older water-wasting fixtures** with high-efficiency, WaterSense and/or Energy Star-labeled models.
- **Run only full loads** in dishwashers and washing machines.
- **Use a 5-gallon bucket** to collect water while your shower heats up. Reuse the water for flushing your toilet or watering indoor or outdoor plants.
- **Monitor your water bill** for spikes in your water use. This often indicates a leak.
