**Project Title:** Auburn Folsom Water Main Replacement and Cavitt Stallman Water Main Pipeline

**Project Applicant:** San Juan Water District (SJWD)

**Project Location - Specific:** The Project is located within San Juan Water District's Retail Service Area, and all portions of the Project are within the existing public rights-of-way and easements within Placer County, CA.

**Project Location – Cities:** Granite Bay **Project Location – Counties:** Placer

**Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:** Project includes replacing approximately 130-LF of existing, old, failing pipeline with new 6-in Ductile Iron on Auburn Folsom Road from address 8065 to address 8015, and replacing 6 water services on Auburn Folsom Road, in Granite Bay. Project also includes installation of approximately 460-LF of new 12-in, 90-LF of new 10-in, and 40-LF of new 8-in C900 pipeline, 80-LF of new 12-in Ductile Iron pipeline, and replacing 2 water services on Cavitt Stallman Road between Mystery Creek Lane and Oak Pine Lane in Granite Bay. Project includes installation of valves, fittings, hydrants, concrete blocking, and appurtenances. Pipelines and water services will have an approximate depth of cover of 36-inches. The Project benefits SJWD's water customers.
