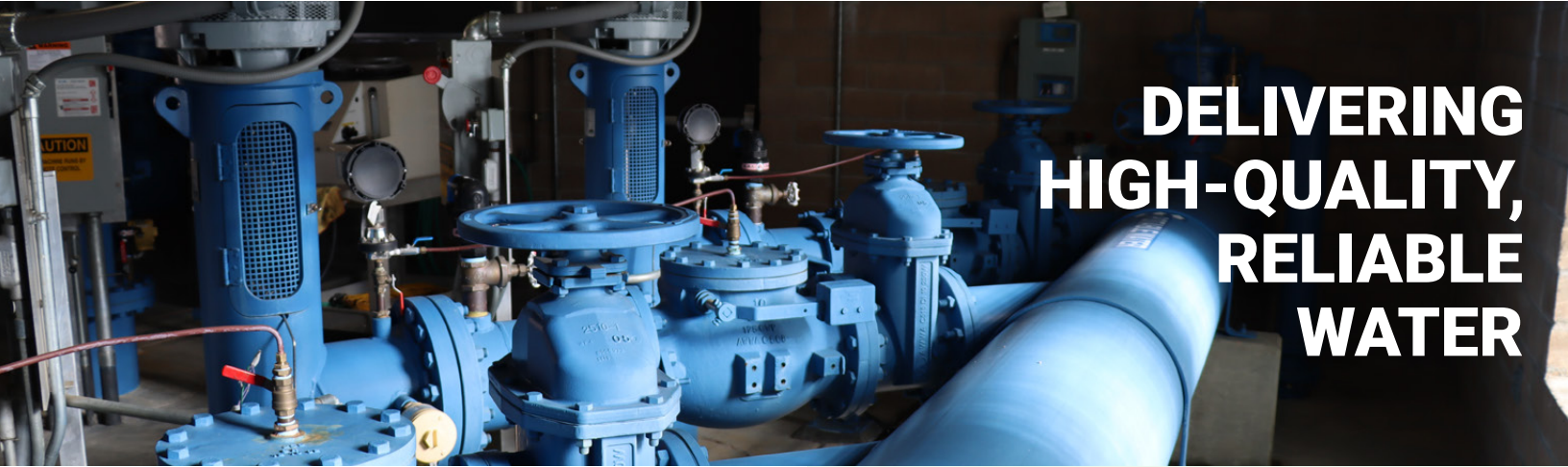

With the addition of DocAccess, all PDFs accessed through our website are automatically converted into an accessible, mobile-friendly HTML format. This makes public documents easier to read, navigate, and interact with for all users.

Key features include:

- Translation into more than 150 languages

- Built-in tools such as “Ask a Question”

WATER-SAVING TIPS FOR THE SUMMER

As temperatures rise, summer is a great time to refresh your watering habits. The following tips offer simple ways to improve water efficiency and help your landscape thrive throughout the summer months.



Landscaping

- Apply 3-4 inches of bark or organic mulch around plants to help retain soil moisture and reduce evaporation.
- Group plants with similar water needs together and place higher-water-use plants at the base of slopes to benefit from natural drainage.
- Choose native and drought-tolerant plant varieties whenever possible.
- If your landscaping is on a slope, water in shorter intervals to minimize runoff and allow water to soak in more effectively.



Lawn Care

- Raise your lawnmower blade height to help grass retain moisture and reduce water use.
- Aerate your lawn regularly so water can reach the roots more efficiently.
- Upgrade traditional spray-head sprinklers to high-efficiency MP Rotators, which apply water more slowly and evenly.
- Before watering, step on your lawn – if the grass springs back quickly, it likely doesn't need water yet.



Pools, Spas and General Outdoor Use

- Use a pool cover to reduce evaporation and keep the water cleaner for longer.
- Maintain proper chemical levels in spas and fountains to extend water life and reduce the need for draining.
- If you need to drain your spa, reuse the water for landscaping or plants.
- Take your car to a commercial car wash that uses recycled water, or wash it at home using a bucket and hose nozzle to minimize water waste.
