

LAWRENCE DRIVE SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT COMPLETED

San Juan Water District recently completed the Lawrence Drive Service Line Replacement Project in Granite Bay. The project proactively replaced service laterals and fire hydrants that were in poor condition or nearing the end of their service life. Our Field Services team coordinated the work with a construction contractor and divided the project into multiple outage sections to minimize the impact on our customers.

The Lawrence Drive project is a great example of the District's commitment to proactive maintenance and long-term system reliability. By investing in our infrastructure before problems occur, we can help reduce emergency repairs and continue providing safe, reliable water service for our customers. The project included the replacement of 21 services, 2 hydrants, 1 air release valve, and 1 gate valve, as well as the installation of full-circle repair bands where existing service taps needed to be relocated or ended.
