

## SAN JUAN WATER DISTRICT NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Board of Directors of the San Juan Water District will hold public hearings both in-person at the District Office, 9935 Auburn Folsom Rd, Granite Bay, CA 95746, and via videoconference in accordance with the Executive Orders N-29-20 and N-25-20 regarding the COVID-19 emergency, on the following dates:

Wednesday, June 23, 2021, at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard. This public hearing is to receive public comments and input regarding the draft 2020 Urban Water Management Plan Update (UWMP) and 2020 Water Shortage Contingency Plans (WSCPs).

All interested parties are invited to attend the public hearing and express opinions or submit information.

**PARTICIPATION DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC:** Due to State guidelines on physical distancing in public gatherings, the Boardroom can accommodate a maximum of 10 members of the public at one time. The District recommends that members of the public participate in Board meetings via videoconference per the instructions below. **PUBLIC COMMENTS:** All interested parties are invited to attend the public hearing to provide comments or send written comments to the Water Resources Manager, Greg Zlotnick, at the San Juan Water District Office, 9935 Auburn Folsom Rd, Granite Bay, CA 95746, or via email to [gzlotnick@sjwd.org](mailto:gzlotnick@sjwd.org), no later than the close of the public hearing.

The District does not transcribe its proceedings. Persons who wish to obtain a verbatim record of the proceedings should arrange for attendance by a court reporter. Such arrangements will be at the sole expense of the person requesting the recordation.

If you challenge the action taken on this matter in court, the challenge may be limited to only those issues raised at the public hearings described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Secretary for the Board at, or prior to, the public hearings.

After the public hearings, the Board will consider adopting the retail and wholesale UWMPs and WSCPs as drafted or with changes based on public and staff input.
