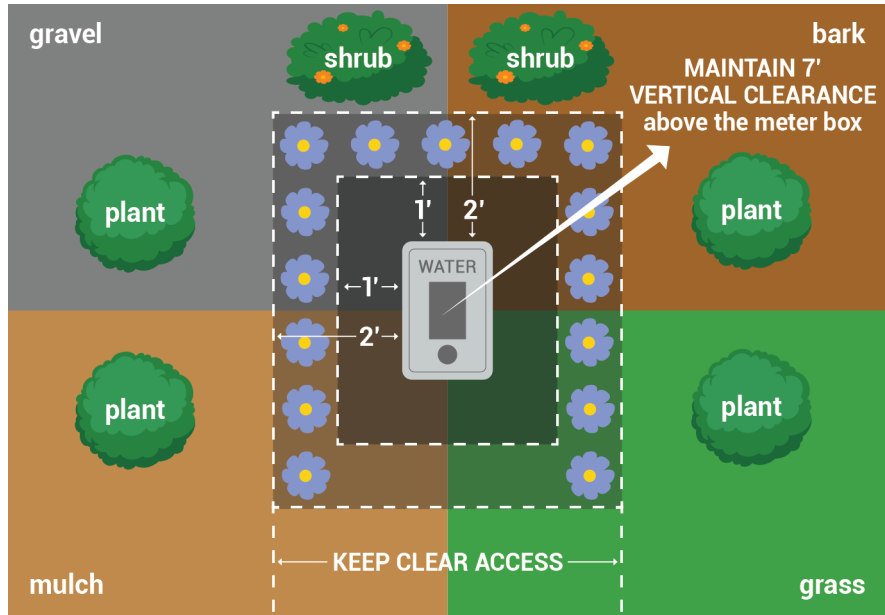


REMINDER: METER BOX CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS

Is your meter box clear and visible, or is it hidden underneath the plants? Please remember that it needs to be accessible so the meter can be read, and any necessary maintenance can be performed. Other than turf grass, gravel, bark, mulch or dirt, no planting material should be located within the one-foot perimeter of the meter box.

If you see a blue flag in your yard and receive a letter requesting that your meter box is cleared of any landscape material, please do so at your earliest convenience.

FUNDING SECURED FOR RESERVOIR REPLACEMENT PROJECT

SJWD has secured \$1,250,000 in funding from the Environmental Protection Agency's State and Tribal Assistance Grants account for the Kokila Reservoir Replacement Project. This essential project will benefit approximately 330,000 residents in Placer and Sacramento counties by safeguarding public health and safety and maintaining reliable drinking water distribution.

The Kokila Reservoir plays a vital role in the distribution of surface water supplies and groundwater from banked supplies within our service area and the greater Sacramento region. Congressman Kevin Kiley, Representative for California's 3rd Congressional District, sponsored the funding.
