LET YOUR LAWN GO DORMANT

It is a great time to let your lawn go dormant for the cooler seasons. When your lawn goes dormant, it will eventually recover. Trees, however, can be lost forever.

Remember to turn off your irrigation system during the winter months. Take the guesswork out of watering and upgrade to a weather-based sprinkler timer. INDOOR WATER SAVING TIPS



Kitchen
Try installing an aerator on your kitchen faucet to reduce your water flow. Consider installing a water and energy efficient dishwasher and run it only when it's full and save up to three to eight gallons of water per load.



Bathroom
Install WaterSense labeled fixtures around the house. High-efficiency toilets, bathroom faucets and showerheads save gallons of water a year and you may even be able to get a rebate. Visit sjwd.org/rebate-applications to find out how you can save.



Laundry
Make sure to wash only full loads of clothes and you could save 15 to 45 gallons of water per load.
